Center for Safety & Change is seeking a full-time Community Educator. This 35-hour per week, position is a non-exempt role that reports to the Program Manager of School-Based Programs. The Community Educator is responsible for training middle school, high school and college-age students on gender based violence, other forms of oppression, and teen activism.

This position requires flexible hours, which may include early mornings, evenings and weekends. An interest in social justice issues and experience working with teens is desirable. The successful candidate must possess strong computer skills, including proficiency in Microsoft Suite and social networking.

The mission of the Center for Safety & Change is to develop strategies to end gender-based violence and provide shelter, legal and supportive services that empower survivors of domestic violence, sexual abuse and human trafficking. - Community organizing experience a plus.
- Must have experience in public speaking, social networking, and working with youth.
- Bilingual/bicultural candidates encouraged to apply.
- This position requires the ability to occasionally lift up to 10 pounds.
