Job Type	Volunteer/unpaid
Purpose	To provide child care for clients who are attending support groups, meetings or appointments
Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lead and supervise play activities with children, including arts and crafts, sports, music, etc• Assist with homework• Role model appropriate behaviors• Observe children's behavior and report issues to staff• Assist with clean-up• Perform other duties as assigned
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 16 years of age or older• Prior experience working with children• Strong interpersonal skills• Ability to work both independently and as part of a team• Willing to work in an environment where children may be in distress• Flexible and willing to work on a variety of tasks• Creative• Able to establish rapport and work with children of diverse ages and cultural backgrounds• Background check required• Required to sign confidentiality agreement
Location	Emergency Shelter, Main Office, or satellite office
Reports to	Director of Children's Services at Main Office or Children's Advocate at the Shelter
Hours	Choice of day and evenings; weekdays, weekends and holidays (as needed)
Duration of Assignment	Ongoing and year-round
Training Provided	General orientation by the Coordinator of Volunteer Services and/or Children's Program Director On-site training by supervisor
